

## **ORDINANCE 2021-15**

### **AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SMYRNA, GEORGIA, PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SMYRNA, CHAPTER 6, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, TO AMEND SECTION 6-2 AND 6-85.**

The following are proposed code amendments to several sections of the Chapter 6 of the City Ordinance and are presented in legislative draft format:

***Amend Section 6-2 of Chapter 6 – Alcoholic Beverage Ordinance to add the following definitions:***

#### **Sec. 6-2. - Definitions.**

Private dog park means a privately owned and operated dog park. Any such facility shall have a minimum of 25-dues paying members; and shall derive no more than 50 percent of its total annual gross revenue from alcohol sales. Total annual gross revenue may include daily rates, memberships, non-alcoholic beverages, pre-packaged snacks, merchandise sales, special event proceeds, and dog treats as revenue sources.

Except as provided in this definition, a private dog park shall be subject to the same requirements as on-premises eating establishments, including hours of permitted alcohol sales.

***Add Section 6-85 to Chapter 6 – Alcoholic Beverage Ordinance to add the pouring license requirements for private dog parks:***

#### **Sec. 6-85. – Private Dog Parks.**

In order to be eligible for a pouring license, a private dog park must meet the definition of private dog park as set forth in Section 6-2 herein as well as the following requirements:

- (1) Has a minimum of 25 due-paying members;
- (2) Derives no more than 50 percent of its total annual gross revenue from alcohol sales. Total annual gross revenue may include daily rates, memberships, non-alcoholic beverages, pre-packaged snacks, merchandise sales, special event proceeds, and dog treats as revenue sources.

Except as provided in this definition, a private dog park shall be subject to the same requirements as on-premises eating establishments, including hours of permitted alcohol sales

This ordinance shall take effect on September 1, 2021 and is passed and duly adopted this 16th day of August 2021.
