

ORDINANCE 2022-03

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SMYRNA MAYOR
AND CITY COUNCIL, TO AMEND ARTICLE V, SECTION
46-148 (f) AND (g) TO READ AS FOLLOWS**

(f) Overbank Flood Protection: Downstream overbank flood protection shall be provided by controlling the post-development peak discharge rate to a rate at least ten percent less than the pre-development rate for all the following: the two-year, ten-year, and 25-year, 24-hour return frequency storm events.

(g) Extreme Flood Protection: Extreme flood protection shall be provided by controlling the post-development peak discharge rate to a rate at least ten percent less than the pre-development rate for both the 50-year and the 100-year, 24-hour return frequency storm events.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately and is passed and duly adopted this 7th day of March 2022.
