## **RESOLUTION 2020-12**

WHEREAS, the City has taken over operation of the Smyrna Museum and through that process found various items of property with no historical significance or other value; and

**WHEREAS**, over several years this property was received from unknown sources who have made no efforts to claim the property; and

**WHEREAS**, this property has continuously remained in the museum from the time that it was received; and

**WHEREAS**, the property has not been claimed by any person within 90 days of its discovery; and

WHEREAS, the City reasonably assumes that this property was intended as a gift.

## THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED, as follows:

Pursuant to § 10-1-529.5 (c) all property in the museum that was received from an unknown source and not claimed within 90 days following its discovery and reasonably assumed to have been intended as a gift to the museum and is hereby conclusively presumed to be a gift to the museum. A list of such property will be completed and kept on file at the museum.
