### **RULES**

Competitors must provide a Name for your chili, 5 Gallons of Chili, and a recipe. Chili can be any type of common chili Texas, Skyline, Verde, White Bean, Vegetarian. Recipe must include at least one of the many fine Reformation brews as an ingredient. Judging points will be awarded based on flavor, texture and mouth-feel, consistency with your chosen “style” of chili, innovation, and best use of a Reformation brew. The competition will be judged by 5 (or more) unaffiliated judges in a blind tasting and awarded points based on the above criteria, to be tallied and reported during the awards ceremony at 5:00pm.
