

Resolution 2018-02

Resolution Calling for Special Election, Setting Qualifying Dates, Setting a Qualifying Fee, and approving a contract between Cobb County Board of Elections and The City of Smyrna and authorizing the Mayor to execute the contract

WHEREAS, the council member for ward 6 has resigned his position effective February 15, 2018; and

WHEREAS there is currently scheduled a Primary election for May 22, 2018 and said election covers all of Ward 6; and

WHEREAS, it would benefit the city and residents of Ward 6 to include a special election for the newly vacated council position with the election already scheduled for May 22, 2018.

THEREFORE, be it resolved as follows:

1. A special Election for the Ward 6 Council Member is hereby called to occur on May 22, 2018.
2. The qualifying dates will be set for Monday and Tuesday, March 5 and 6, 2018; 8:30 AM – 4:30 PM with one hour for lunch between 12:00 PM and 1:00 PM and Wednesday March 7, 2018; 8:30 AM – 12:30 PM.
3. The qualifying fee shall be \$567.00 which is 3% of the gross salary of the office.
4. The City is authorized to enter into a contract with the Cobb County Board of Elections to conduct such Special Election and the Mayor is authorized to execute such agreement.
