Dear Mr. Suddreth:

The City of Smyrna previously received hazard mitigation assistance from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for property acquisition. Per the Grantee-Subgrantee Agreement between the City of Smyrna and the Georgia Emergency Management Agency and per the warranty deed restrictions, property acquired must be maintained for open space, recreational, or wetlands practices in perpetuity. The City of Smyrna is responsible for the continued maintenance of the acquired properties and for ensuring that the property is maintained in accordance with required land use restrictions listed under 44 CFR Part 80.19(d). The FEMA Deed Restrictions Guidelines are enclosed for your review.

Enclosed is a list of properties in your local community that were acquired with FEMA mitigation funds. These properties are bound by the grant agreement and deed restrictions, and must comply with 44 CFR Part 80.19(d). Please certify the listed properties are in compliance with this regulation. **Please return signed form to this office no later than February 28, 2014.**




