

Sec. 2-3. - Nongovernmental use of city property.

The following rules shall apply in the nongovernmental use of city meeting rooms, recreation areas and other city property or facilities:

- (1) The council chamber shall be used only for council meetings and merit board meetings and other governmental board meetings unless when nongovernmental use is authorized by the mayor and council.
- (2) ~~As to the courtroom, fire department meeting room and other meeting rooms. All city conference rooms and other meeting spaces, when not in use by City departments, may when not in use by city departments, agencies, etc., such meeting rooms may~~ be used by nongovernmental groups upon authorization by the chair of the committee department head having control thereof, or his/her designated agent, and upon payment of any necessary usage fee.
- (3) Recreational facilities and parks at other than the usual hours and the usual activity, may be used by nongovernmental groups with by the authorization of the department head chair of the committee having control thereof, or his/her designated agent, acquisition of any required permits, and upon payment of any necessary usage fee.
