BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF SMYRNA

MEMORIAL DAY POPPY DISTRIBUTION

WHEREAS: America is the land of freedom, preserved and protected willingly and freely by citizen soldiers; and

WHEREAS: Millions who have answered the call to arms have died on the field of battle; and

WHEREAS: A nation at peace must be reminded of the price of war and the debt owed to those who have died in war; and

WHEREAS: The red poppy has been designated as a symbol of sacrifice of lives in all wars; and

WHEREAS: The American Legion Auxiliary has pledged to remind America annually of this debt through the distribution of the memorial flower; NOW

THEREFORE: I, A. Max Bacon, Mayor of the City of Smyrna, Georgia do hereby proclaim during the month of May in 2019, the 11th, 18th, and 27th as **MEMORIAL DAY POPPY DISTRIBUTION** and ask that all citizens pay tribute to those who have made the ultimate sacrifice in the name of freedom by wearing the Memorial Poppy.
