

ORDINANCE 2016-05

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SMYRNA, GEORGIA, PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SMYRNA, CHAPTER 2, ADMINISTRATION, ARTICLE I, IN GENERAL to amend Section 2-3

Section 2-3. - Nongovernmental use of city property

The following rules shall apply in the nongovernmental use of city meeting rooms, recreation areas and other city property or facilities:

- (1) The council chamber shall be used only for council meetings and merit board meetings and other governmental board meetings unless nongovernmental use is authorized by the mayor and council.
- (2) All city conference rooms and other meeting spaces, when not in use by City departments, may be used by nongovernmental groups upon authorization by the department head having control thereof, or his/her designated agent, and upon payment of any necessary usage fee.
- (3) Recreational facilities and parks may be used by nongovernmental groups with the authorization of the department head having control thereof, or his/her designated agent, acquisition of any required permits, and upon payment of any necessary usage fee.
