ISSUE:

BACKGROUND:

The City of Smyrna requested proposals for a three-year contract for Fire Systems Maintenance, including annual inspections of citywide Sprinkler, Fire Alarms, Fire Extinguishers and Fire Suppression systems and Hood Suppression. Eighteen suppliers requested the proposal documents and one bid was received from our current provider, All-Star Fire, LLC in the amount of \$66,917.00. All-Star Fire has been our contractor provider since November 2015. Due to ongoing performance issues and equipment with expired tags and non-repair we have opted to reject the bid.

We researched other solutions including Cobb County and cooperative contracts. Cintas has provided a fire protection services agreement using Omnia Partners cooperative. Cintas will perform the inspections for the total cost of \$15,668.75 and repairs and replacement equipment will be priced using the Omnia Partners preferred contract customer rates.

RECOMMENDATION/REQUESTED ACTION:
