

RESOLUTION 2022-10

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SMYRNA TO IMPOSE A MORATORIUM ON ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS SEEKING TO REZONE PROPERTY TO BE DEVELOPED OR OTHERWISE USED AS A TOWNHOME OR TOWNHOME DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS, after considering recommendations from staff and seeking public input, the City of Smyrna concludes that it is necessary and desirable to evaluate existing design standards for new town home units and to consider other amendments to the zoning ordinances regarding town home developments.

THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED, as follows:

The City hereby imposes a moratorium on accepting applications seeking to rezone property to be developed or otherwise used as a townhome or townhome development.

Additionally, the city hereby imposed a moratorium on accepting applications seeking a variance from existing regulations that would allow the property to be developed or otherwise used as a townhome or townhome development.

Unless sooner terminated by an act of this city council, this moratorium begins September 15, 2022 and extends through and including September 19, 2022, during which time the city will evaluate new unit design standards and other potential amendments to the applicable zoning ordinances or adoption of new ordinances regarding townhomes or town home developments.

This Resolution was adopted by the Governing Authority of the City of Smyrna, Georgia on the 15th day of August 2022.
