## Agenda Title:

<u>Public Hearing</u> - Zoning Request - Z21-009 - Allow rezoning from R-15 to RDA Conditional for two single-family detached homes at a density of 5.18 units per acre - Land Lot 486 - 1084 Medlin Street - Kimberly Norwood Properties LLC.

## **ISSUE AND BACKGROUND:**

The applicant is requesting a rezoning from R-15 to RDA-Conditional for the development of two (2) single-family detached units at a density of 5.18 units per acre. A land use change from Medium Density Residential is not required for this rezoning. The Planning & Zoning Board recommended approval by a vote of 5-0 at the July 12, 2021 meeting.

**RECOMMENDATION / REQUESTED ACTION**: Community Development recommends <u>approval</u> of the rezoning from R-15 to RDA-Conditional for the development of two single-family units at a density of 5.18 units per acre with the following conditions:

#### **Standard Conditions**

Requirements # 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 12, and 17 from Section 1201 of the Zoning Code are not applicable.

- 1.The composition of the homes in a residential subdivision shall include a mixture of element including; but not limited to: brick, stone, shake, hardy plank and stucco. No elevation shall be comprised of 100% hardy plank siding. The residences whose lots abut external roadways shall not be permitted to utilize hardy plank for any elevation facing these roads.
- 2.All utilities within the development shall be underground.
- 3.The developer shall be responsible for any traffic improvements (including additional right-of-way dedications) deemed necessary by either the City or the County during construction plan review. Sidewalks shall be provided by the developer inside the subdivision and outside the subdivision adjacent to any public right-of-way consistent with city's requirements for the extent of the development. A grass buffer with a minimum width of two

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feet shall be provided between the back of curb and sidewalk.

- 4. No debris may be buried on any lot or common area.
- 5. The developer will comply with the Citsy current tree ordinance. All required tree protection measures shall be adhered to by the developer during construction.
- 6.All yards and common areas are to be sodded, and landscaped. Irrigate as appropriate.
- 7.All singleamily and/or duplex residential lots shall provide the following at the time of certificate of occupancy: either four 3" caliper trees or three 4" caliper trees. The following species of trees may be used: Nuttall Oak, Swamp Chestnut Oak, Allee Elm, and Village Green Zelkova. Other species may be used if approved by the City.

#### **Special Conditions**

8. The development shall maintain the RDA setbacks:

Front - 25' Street Side - 13' Side - 5' Rear - 25'

- 9. The minimum lot size shall be 7,201 sq. ft.
- 10. The minimum lot width shall be 50 feet.
- 11. Driveway 22' minimum length from building face to back of sidewalk.
- 12. The developer shall dedicate 5 ft. of right-of-way dedication along Hollis Street.
- 13. The developer shall install 5a ft. sidewalk and 2 ft. grass strip at the frontage of property along Hollis and Medlin Street.
- 14.All structures will be built to a maximum height 65 as measured from the sidewalk along the front elevation.
- 15.The developer shall meet all fire access requirements deemed necessary by the Fire Marsl during construction plan review.
- 16.The developer shall be responsible for any water and sewer improvements deemed necess by the Public Works Director during construction plan review.
- 17. The developer shall be responsible for any stormwater improvements deemed necessary the City Engineer.
- 18.Approval of the subject property for the RECA onditional zoning district shall be conditioned upon the development of the property in substantial compliance with the site plan submitted 6/15/2021 and created by SJMurphy LLC and all zoning stipulations above.
- 19.Approval of the subject property shall be conditioned upon substantial compliance with 1

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elevations submitted on 6/15/2021.
