

- TREE PRESERVATION REPLACEMENT NOTES**
1. All tree protection measures shall be installed prior to any alteration, demolition, or land disturbing activity that requires the issuance of a development permit. Call the Community Development Department at (770) 319-5387 for an inspection.
 2. All buffers shall be replanted to buffer standards, where sparsely vegetated or where disturbed. Replantings are subject to Community Development Department approval.
 3. Tree protection shall be enforced according to the City of Smyrna standards. No activities (including solvents, materials, and construction machinery placement or temporary soil deposits) are to occur within six feet outside the tree protection zones.
 4. Avoid falling trees into protection zones or disturbing roots inside the protection zones. Roots shall be cut cleanly before tree removal.
 5. All tree protection devices must remain in functioning condition until the Certificate of Occupancy is issued.
 6. All debris from trees cut or substantially damaged shall be removed from the site prior to stump above the original natural grade or elevation of land.
 7. The density requirements shown on the Tree Preservation and/or Tree Replacement Plan(s) must be verified prior to the issuance of the Certificate of Occupancy. Call the Community Development Department for an inspection.
 8. A maintenance inspection of trees will be performed after two full growing seasons, or one full growing season on sites with an automatic irrigation system, from the date of the Certificate of Occupancy. Project owners at the time of the maintenance inspection are responsible for ordinance compliance.

*specimen tree protection requires orange polyethylene fence be replaced with chain link fence.





Figure 11: Tree Planting Detail
