RE: Parking restriction on Corn Road

Upon request of the City of Smyrna Department of Public Works Director, we reviewed the concerns expressed by one of the business owners on Corn Road regarding the obstruction of the roadway by cars parked adjacent to Lexington Trace. In particular, vehicles parked in this area affect the movement of commercial vehicles into and out of this driveway.

In reviewing the conditions at the site, we noted that the roadway width is approximately 2' narrower than our current design standards. We also that there is regular accumulation of leafy debris in the gutter on the north side of Corn Road, which would tend to make drivers park further from the curb than normal. Both of these conditions would create a significant impact on a commercial truck trying to negotiate into or out of a driveway in the presence of cars parked along this segment of the road.

In light of these observations, we recommend the council approve a no parking zone as requested on on corn Road.
