

**RESOLUTION 2020-14**

**EMERGENCY 911 TELEPHONE SERVICE**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Smyrna is operating an enhanced **911** system which facilitates the dispatching of emergency services to the residents of Smyrna; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Smyrna has imposed and collected a monthly **911** charge of \$1.50 from telephone subscribers within the area served by such system; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Smyrna has established a separate restricted revenue fund into which the **911** charges are deposited; and

**WHEREAS**, these funds alone are not sufficient to pay for the operation of the enhanced **911** system; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Smyrna must annually reaffirm the need for the \$1.50 **911** charge on telephone subscribers;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City of Smyrna City Council, by resolution, reaffirm the necessity for the \$1.50 **911** charge on telephone subscribers served by the enhanced **911** system for the fiscal year.
