Estimates for Pedestrian Lighting on Spring & Atlanta Road

Spring Road

- From Bell Drive to CSX Bridge
- \$983,800
- Pedestrian lights placed on the North (linear park) side
- 80 foot spacing
- Priced at \$115/linear feet

Atlanta Road

- From Concord Road to City Limits (Ridge Road)
- \$849,700
- Pedestrian lights most likely on West side
- 80 foot spacing
- Priced at \$115/linear feet



Full design and hard quote would take 4 weeks

Google Fiber Update

- Change in leadership
 - New CEO Greg McCray
 - Been in place for about a month
 - Has confirmed commitment to the Atlanta Metro area
- Changing the process for laying/installing the fiber
 - The underground method Google has been using is proving to be too problematic (across entire metro area) and cost prohibitive.
 - Google has been testing a new process called "micro-trenching" in other markets, but has not officially confirmed this new method yet.
 - Greg McCray has extensive background in "micro-trenching"
