A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SMYRNA TO SUPPORT THE CITY'S APPLICATION TO THE GEORGIA INITIATIVE FOR COMMUNITY HOUSING AND THE FORMATION OF A COMMUNITY HOUSING TEAM
