ISSUE: The Community Development Department is seeking approval of the transmittal of the Smyrna 2040 Comprehensive Plan to the Atlanta Regional Commission and the Georgia Department of Community Affairs.

GROUND: The Comprehensive Plan for Smyrna, Georgia is mandated by the Georgia Planning Act 634 gia Law 1989, pp. 1317-1391). This act requires that each jurisdiction in the state prepare and implement a rehensive Plan, which is reviewed by the regional development commission. For the City of Smyrna, the all development commission is the Atlanta Regional Commission (ARC). The rules and regulations of the Act attended to provide a framework to facilitate and encourage coordinated, comprehensive planning and pment at the local, regional, and state government level". Chapter 110-12-1- .02 - .08 of the act sets arm standards for each jurisdiction.
